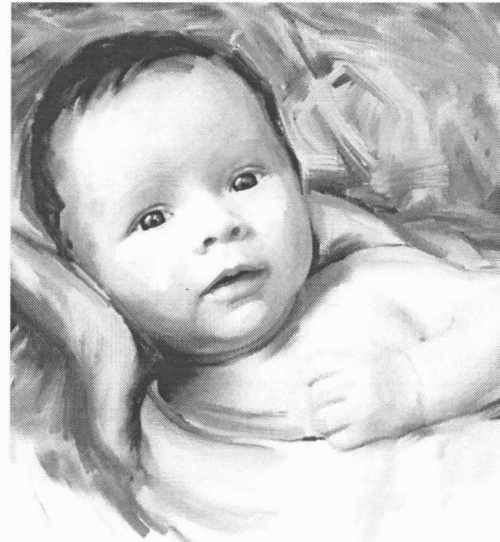

### **ND Tax Credit for Gifts to Endowments**

Since 2007, planned gifts to endowment funds have been eligible for a  
40% tax credit. In 2011 the ND legislature extended this tax credit for  
outright gifts to endowment funds. Individuals may receive a state tax  
credit for a contribution of \$5,000 or more to your parish, school or  
diocese endowment. The credit is 40% of the charitable deduction  
allowed by the IRS up to a maximum credit of \$10,000 per year per  
taxpayer.
