Marks of the Church

One- Under the authority of Christ, the leadership of the pope and his fellow bishops, and the common faith we profess, all Christians who believe in the Trinity are all part of one body.

Holy- God grants holiness on his Church through the sacraments, which sanctify, strengthen, and renew us to perform Christ's work in the world.

Catholic- The Church is "catholic"- for everyone. As the Church spreads around the world the same message is taught and the same Eucharist is celebrated.

Apostolic- The Holy Spirit guides the Church to truth through the gift of apostolic succession. The authority of the Church was given by Jesus to the apostles and handed down through the popes.
