"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened and I will give you rest." In times of trials and in moments of despair, we may begin to question if God cares for us. Today's Gospel puts these doubts to rest, by assuring us that despite any turmoil or difficulties in our lives, God is with us always. Jesus shares our every burden and pleads with us to come to Him and receive the peace and strength needed to carry our heavy crosses. Do not lose sleep and needed rest because of concerns about life's problems. Bring them to Jesus and enjoy the rest He offers, the consolation of resting in His loving hands.

The Spiritual Works of Mercy, *Comfort the Afflicted*

Definition: It is an act of love to help other people in any kind of sorrow and to refrain from doing anything that would unnecessarily cause another person more sorrow.

Scriptural basis: Psalms 9: 8-11; 22: 23-27; 27: 4-5; 30:2-4; 46: 2; 55: 22; 56; 71: 20-22; 116; 119: 49-50

Jeremiah 29:11-14; Lamentations 3: 21-24; 31-33;
Nahum 1:7-8

Matthew 11:28-30; John 14: 15-18, 27; 16:22-23; II
Corinthians 5:17; I Peter 5:5-11; Revelation 21: 4

Applications: 1) Walk with others through their pain; 2) Offer words of encouragement to those who seem discouraged. Do not walk by, claiming, "It's not my place to interfere." But it is, because compassion is expected of Christians; 3) Offer positive words to fellow students or coworkers who are having a difficult time with their tasks; 4) Be present to those who are struggling or are in emotional pain or despair; 5) Offer sympathy to those who are grieving. If you do not know what to say, give them a hug. This speaks volumes of your sympathy for them; 6) Offer to pray with and for those who are experiencing trials and difficulties; 7) Remind people how much they are loved and needed. This world is a better place because of them.

Breaking Free

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches, "Sexuality affects all aspects of the human person" (2332). Therefore, if you are under the influence of a life-dominating sexual sin like pornography addiction, you need to take radical steps to reorient your life. You must develop a protection plan to avoid both the remote and the proximate occasions of sin. This may mean: placing a good filtering program on your computer, tablet, and cell phone; move your home computer to an open location in the home; call upon a good friend when under temptation to pray with you and to encourage you to

fight this sin; cancel any satellite, cable, or streaming service if you are watching programs that lead you into sin; bless with holy water any technological device before you use it; and cultivate a devotion to the Holy Rosary, one of the greatest spiritual sacramentals in the fight against sins of impurity. Know that you are not alone in the battle against pornography, which affects people of both sexes and of all ages. But remember that with the grace of Jesus, He will allow you to cast off this work of darkness and to put on His armor of light. Praise God that in the battle against pornography, no one is alone, but Jesus is always there to strengthen and to heal.

Thank You for Your Input

I appreciate those who offered their feedback regarding the condition of the rectory basement of Sacred Heart Church. One of the parishioners believes that we must repair this concrete in the basement of the rectory before we can sell it, because no one would buy the rectory for a home with the deplorable state of the basement. I must agree and if you want to tour the basement to determine this for yourself, know that I would be happy to do so. Just to warn you that you will be shocked, because you have likely never seen anything of this nature. But of course, we always have to look at the cost, and how to raise the funds needed. One estimate that has already been provided places fixing the problem at about \$50,000, but that does not include removing the closets and cabinets so that the concrete can be removed along the perimeter of the basement to make room for a drainage field. In addition, a plumber has to lift the water heat pipes, the shower, and the toilet to also repair the concrete along the wall. Then the plumber has to be hired a second time to put all this back into place when the project is completed. How much that will be, we still must ascertain. When the basement is repaired, then we can see what a realtor would offer for the sale of the rectory and use these funds to purchase a home closer to the church. Some people are still opposed to moving the rectory closer to the church, which I find difficult to understand. I could be wrong, but our parish is the only parish in the entire diocese that has a rectory blocks away from the church. That should tell us something; we are out of step with the rest of the diocese. Let us keep discussing this matter so that we can make the best decision for our parish and for her pastor.
